




Dear Families,

We hope that you all are staying healthy and safe. We are extremely grateful that you have chosen our school to educate your scholars. In the time of COVID-19, with the state mandates that have been put in place, we understand that school is going to feel completely different. We are going to have to work together as we transform our school to a distance learning model. Below you will find logistics that you need to know for our school launch of distance learning next week.

Launch Date: Our official launch for distance learning will be Monday, April 6th with a review of the content students were learning just before schools closed. Our goal for next week is to ensure all scholars and families are familiar with the online platform and are able to connect and respond. We will launch official new content for every subject on Monday, April 13th.

Distance Learning Platform: We will use Google Classrooms as our distance learning platform. To log on, your scholar will use their school email address at classroom.google.com, click the plus sign in the top right corner of the page, click "join class", and enter the codes below:

Schedule: Students will have new lessons to complete Monday- Thursday of the week, and all assignments are due for grading on Fridays by 4pm. Fridays are a “choice day” intended for students to catch up on any unfinished assignments and work independently on recommendations provided by teachers under their Friday posts on google classrooms.
