E Prep & Village Prep

Breakthrough's founding Preps model campus, E Prep and Village Prep Cliffs, is located in the St. Clair-Superior neighborhood of Cleveland. The rigorous, college prep curriculum provides students with the foundation needed to achieve success in high school, college, and beyond.

Founded in 2006, Village Prep serves children in grades K-4 and E Prep serves scholars in grades 5-8. The high-performing charter school offers students a structured school culture that focuses on building core academic skills and the development of entrepreneurial character traits such as responsibility and self-discipline.

DISTANCE LEARNING

The last day of in-class instruction for all Breakthrough Public Schools was March 13, 2020, due to mandated state-wide school closures as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Academic leadership created a plan and began distance learning for Breakthrough students on April 8. Students were given a device and assistance with gaining internet connectivity in their homes, including hotspots to those families in need. On average, 87% of Breakthrough students logged in to distance learning on a weekly basis.



SPECIAL EVENTS

E Prep held its first ever spelling bee for students in grades 5-8, which was organized and overseen by Mrs.

Armstrong. The winner was given a trophy and bragging rights for the remainder of the school year.

The nation's first school-based 5G Innovative Learning Lab by Verizon opened at the Cliffs campus. Students were provided equipment and given access to augmented reality, 3D printing, virtual reality, and more to learn and revolutionize.





Cliffs scholars and their families were invited to participate in the first ever Fall Family Fun Fest. Carnival games, arts & crafts, concessions, and throwing pies at teachers made for an exciting night.

Village Prep Cliffs sponsored a Skate for Art event at Zelma Watson George Roller Skating Rink. Admission and raffle ticket proceeds went to the 3rd and 4th grade art program!
