The flagship Citizens and Citizen Leadership model schools, Citizens Academy (CA) and Citizens Leadership Academy (CLA), are located on the Mahatma Gandhi Campus as of June 2022.

CA serves scholars in grades K-4, and CLA serves scholars in grades 5-8. Scholars at CA practice The CA Way, a set of high academic and behavioral expectations that promote the pillars of ambition, personal responsibility, and high structure/support. CLA has a rigorous curriculum with a synergistic approach to teaching based on EL Education, which embraces character building that helps to prepare students for the transition to high school, college, and career.

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3314.03(D)(2) specifies that the sponsor of the school must "monitor and evaluate the academic and fiscal performance and the organization and operation of the community school on at least an annual basis."

Buckeye Community Hope Foundation (BCHF) bases its evaluation of school performance on each of the State required indicators and performance measures listed in the charter contract. BCHF monitors the performance of the community school thru attendance at board meetings, bi-monthly visits to the school, monthly reviews of financial reports and quarterly reviews of academic progress reports along with several other reports relative to the school's performance. Buckeye Community Hope Foundation served as the sponsor for (NAME of Your School) during the 2021-2022 school year and found the school substantially compliant with the rules and regulations governing community schools and progressing towards compliant in academics.

All community school sponsors are required to submit a written report of the evaluation results of the school's academic, financial, and organization performance as well as the school's legal compliance to the Ohio Department of Education and make the report available to parents of students enrolled in the community school. As such, an Annual Report regarding the performance of this school and other schools under the sponsorship of Buckeye Community Hope Foundation will be posted on our website www.buckeyehope.org, no later than November 30, 2022.


